

Step-by-Step: How to Use the Free Tester

Log in or create a free account.

You don't need a paid Canva subscription to edit your invitation.

Click "Use template."

This will open a copy of the design in your own Canva workspace. Start editing.

Click on any text box to update names, dates, or locations.

Want to see your name in script? Try changing the font

Curious about a different color?

Click the text and use the color tool to explore options.

Experiment!

Play around with font sizes, spacing, and layout. This tester is for practice only — there's no pressure to get it perfect.

Download (Optional).

You can even download the test design with a watermark to see how the file saves.

Remember: this tester is not meant for actual use, but it's a fantastic way to see how easy editing your own invite can be.
